Scorpions

How to prevent them-Mechanical

All pest management starts with surveying the area. Look for things like:

- Points of entry.
- Missing weather stripping on doors.
- Torn Door sweeps.
- Windows left open with no screens.
- Holes in your stucco.
- Scorpions can crawl thru the narrowest of openings.
- Pet doors- Keep it closed as much as possible.

How to prevent them-Environmental

Like any creature, Scorpions need food and water. While they can go days without it, they will always gravitate towards an easy meal.

Things to look for in your surroundings:

- Check for dripping water spickets.
- Food and trash left out in the open.
- Places that hold moisture.

Other food sources like our chirpy friend the cricket.



Ants

There are over 3000 species of ants in the world! Ants are the number one reason call for pest service.

How to prevent them-Mechanical

Ants, like scorpions, fit in extremely small places.

Things to look for in your surroundings:

- Missing weather stripping on doors.
- Torn Door sweeps.
- Windows left open with no screens.
- Points of entry-make sure they are sealed
- Pet doors-be aware of scout ants coming and going. Keep it closed as much as possible.

How to prevent them-Environmental

Like all pests, ants love food and water sources!

- Keep your outside surroundings free of trash and discarded food
- If you do store dry items in your garage or outdoors, do it in sealed containers
- Keep your pet food in sealed containers
- If you feed your pets outside, don't leave the food in one place. Don't leave a full bowl out for the entire day.
- Indoor food should be stored in containers.
- With ants, cleanliness will lean in your favor



Rodents

Rodents LOVE to nest, defecate, replicate and chew through just about anything! Believe it or not, they can also squeeze themselves into tiny places.

How to prevent them-Mechanical

All pest management starts with surveying the area. Look for things like:

- Points of entry.
- Missing weather stripping on doors.
- Torn Door sweeps.
- Windows left open with no screens.
- Holes in your stucco.
- Scorpions can crawl thru the narrowest of openings.
- Pet doors- Keep it closed as much as possible.
- Check your roof line for any openings. Rodents love your attic!

How to prevent them-Environmental

Things to look for in your surroundings:

- Like all pests, Rodents also love food and water sources!
- Keep your outside surroundings free of trash and discarded food
- If you do store dry items in your garage or outdoors, do it in sealed containers
- Keep your pet food in sealed containers
- If you feed your pets outside, don't leave the food in one place. Don't leave a full bowl out for the entire day.
- Indoor food should be stored in containers.

As you can see, most preventative measures are primarily the same. It starts with the things we can control like our environment and points of entry. From there, it's a function of regularly scheduled pest management to control the spread and population.
